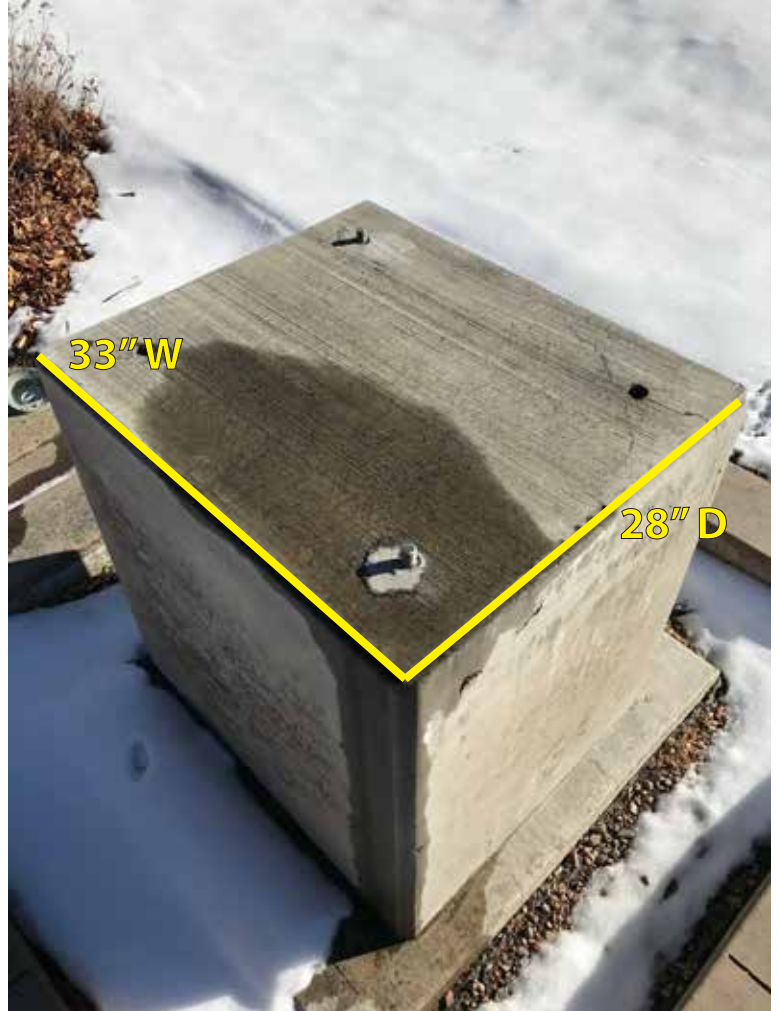


Site #1



Site Information:

-Artist must securely adhere sculpture to existing, concrete, sculpture pedestal for temporary display for up to one year. The addition of concrete anchors and drilling is acceptable, if needed.

-There is a poured concrete pad centered in the pedestal area framed by crushed rock. The rock is then framed by a formed, architectural, concrete edge. Sculpture must fit on existing concrete plinth.

-The site was previously used to display bronze sculpture and is well equipped to handle a significant amount of weight and anchoring.

-Sculpture must be deemed safe and appropriate in nature in order to be considered for public display.

Site #2



Site Information:

- Artist must adhere sculpture to existing, concrete, sculpture pedestal for temporary display for up to one year. The addition of concrete anchors and drilling is acceptable in needed.
