Monroe Street underpass stie details

The Monroe Street underpass is directly adjacent to the South Norwalk train station. This is in a high traffic and quickly developing area of Norwalk, CT. Each side of the underpass measures approximately 10 feet tall by 90 feet long, with sloped retaining walls at both ends. Both sides of the street are to be painted. The perpendicular walls facing east and west on either side are also available. The walls are unpainted concrete. The underpass is on Monroe Street between State Street and Chestnut Street. We encourage artists to visit the site in person or on Google street view.
