

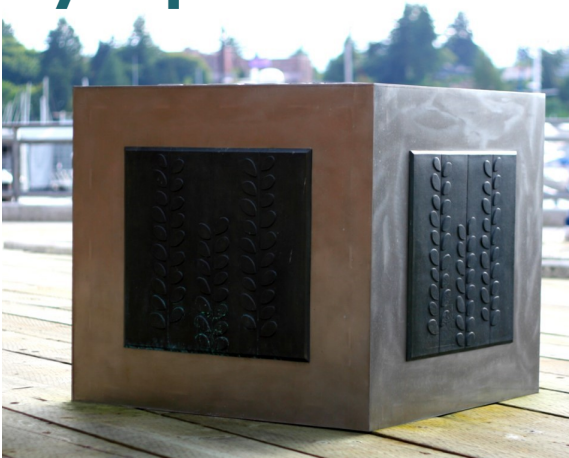


Percival Plinth Project Base Plate Attachment Info

The Percival Plinth Project utilizes a base plate bolting system to display works on various plinth pedestals for the duration of the project year.

Plinth Dimensions: Plinths are 36" wide by 36" deep with varying heights of 30", 36", and 42".

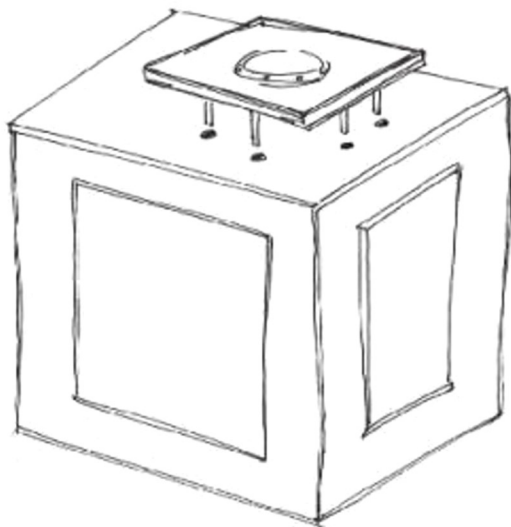
Stainless Steel Attachment plate measures 24" x 24" x 0.25" (provided by City) Artists attach artwork to the plate, and the plate attaches to the plinth by way of 8 bolts. *Some artists have found it helpful to have the specifications of the top view of the plinth complete with plate & plate bolt pattern. 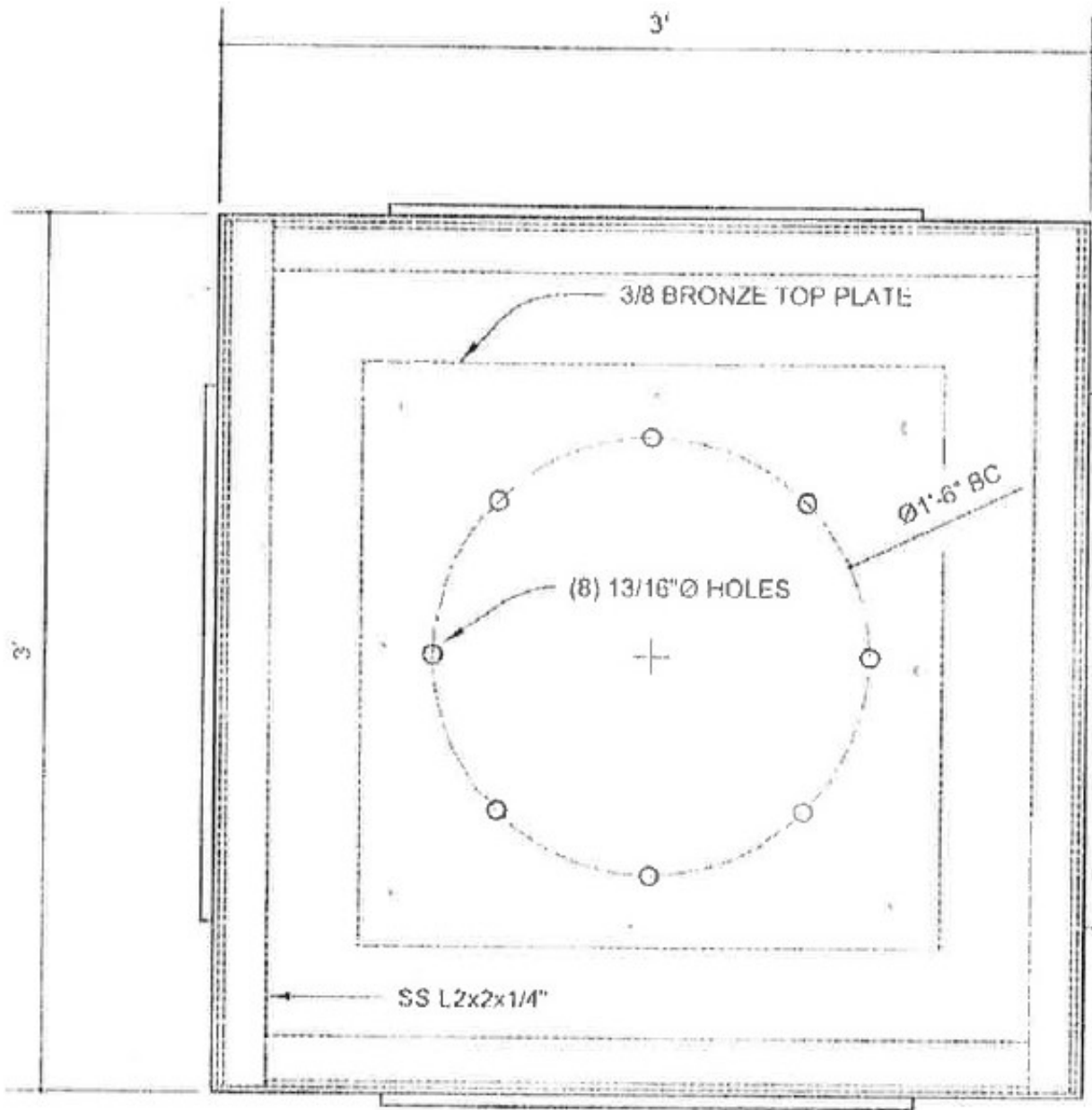
Securing artwork to the plate: Artists must provide a secure connection from sculpture to plate.

- Artists are able to make holes in the plate 1/4" or smaller and/or TIG weld to the attachment plate. (No wire feed.)
- A minimum of 3 contact points are required. Most artists choose 4 or more points of contact.
- Any hardware you add must be installed in a way to remain flush with the underside of the plate. Holes must be countersunk on the underside of the base plate, and attached with flathead screws. This allows the base plate to be mounted to plinth structure without obstruction.
