The renovation of the library will demolish almost all of the original building, except the reading room and the freestanding masonry arch that has become a symbol to the community. The new building will provide more space for staff and the public to expand the programs they offer. The staff area will have 12 workstations plus a manager's office, a processing area for books, conference room, break room, wellness room and well as a staff toilet and storage. The library will have a children's area with a story time room, teen and adult reading areas as well as a computer commons with computer stations and a laptop bar. A larger multi-purpose room will have new AV systems, storage and support spaces and a patio accessed directly from the multi-purpose room. A maker's space and 3 study rooms will also be included. Exterior spaces will include a staff patio, a children's patio, and a patio for teens/adults.
