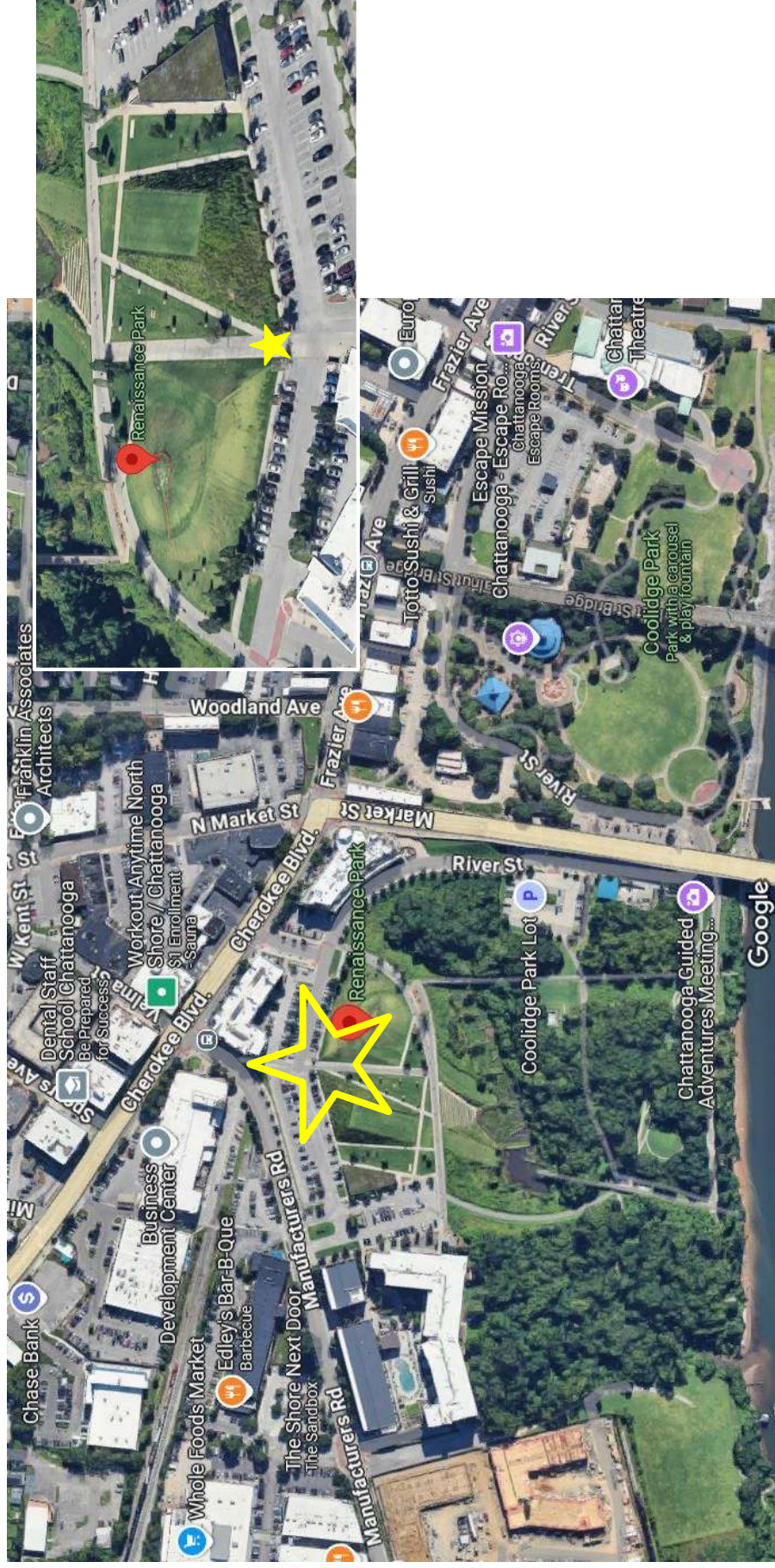

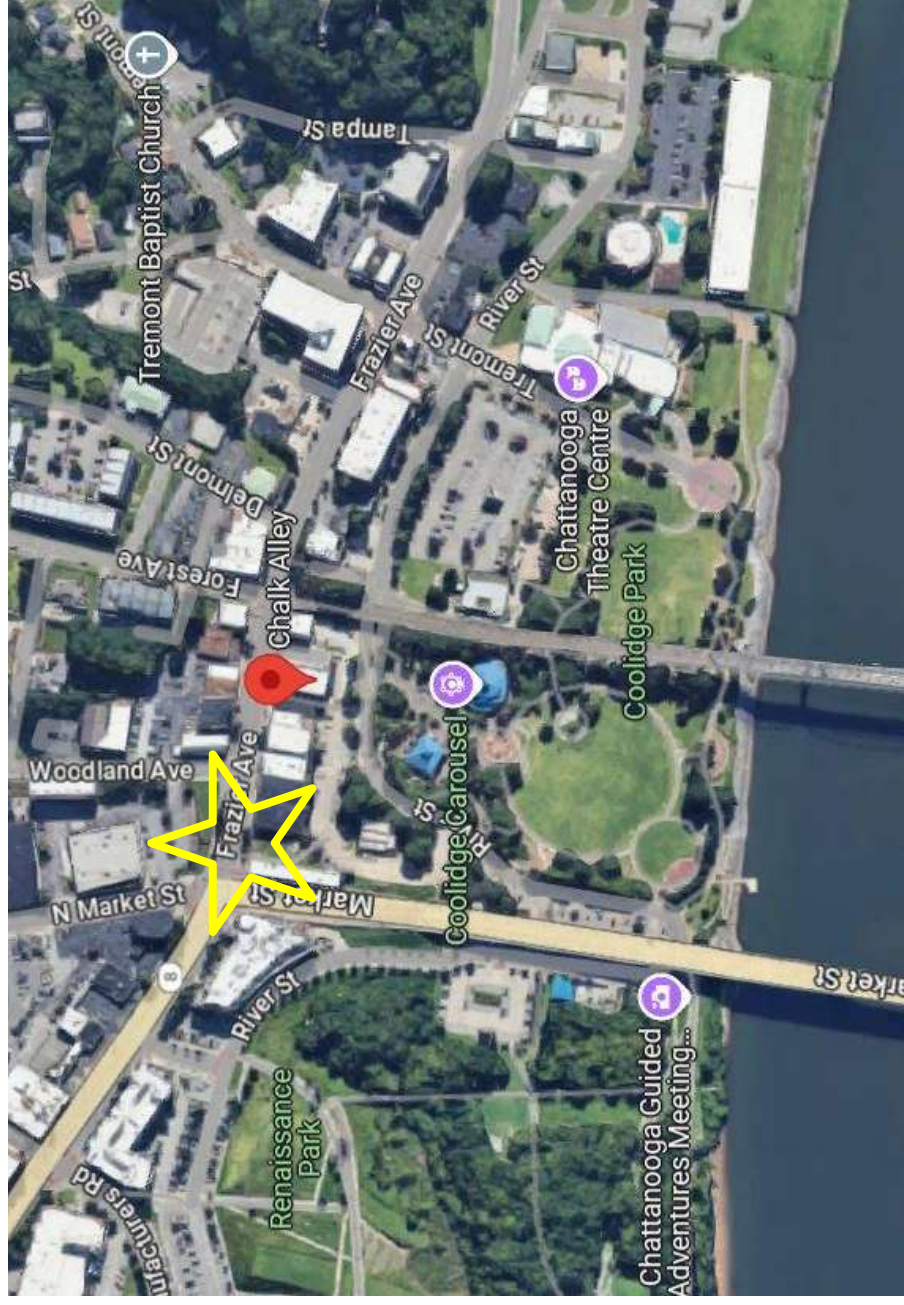


1. Northshore Chattanooga - Renaissance Park

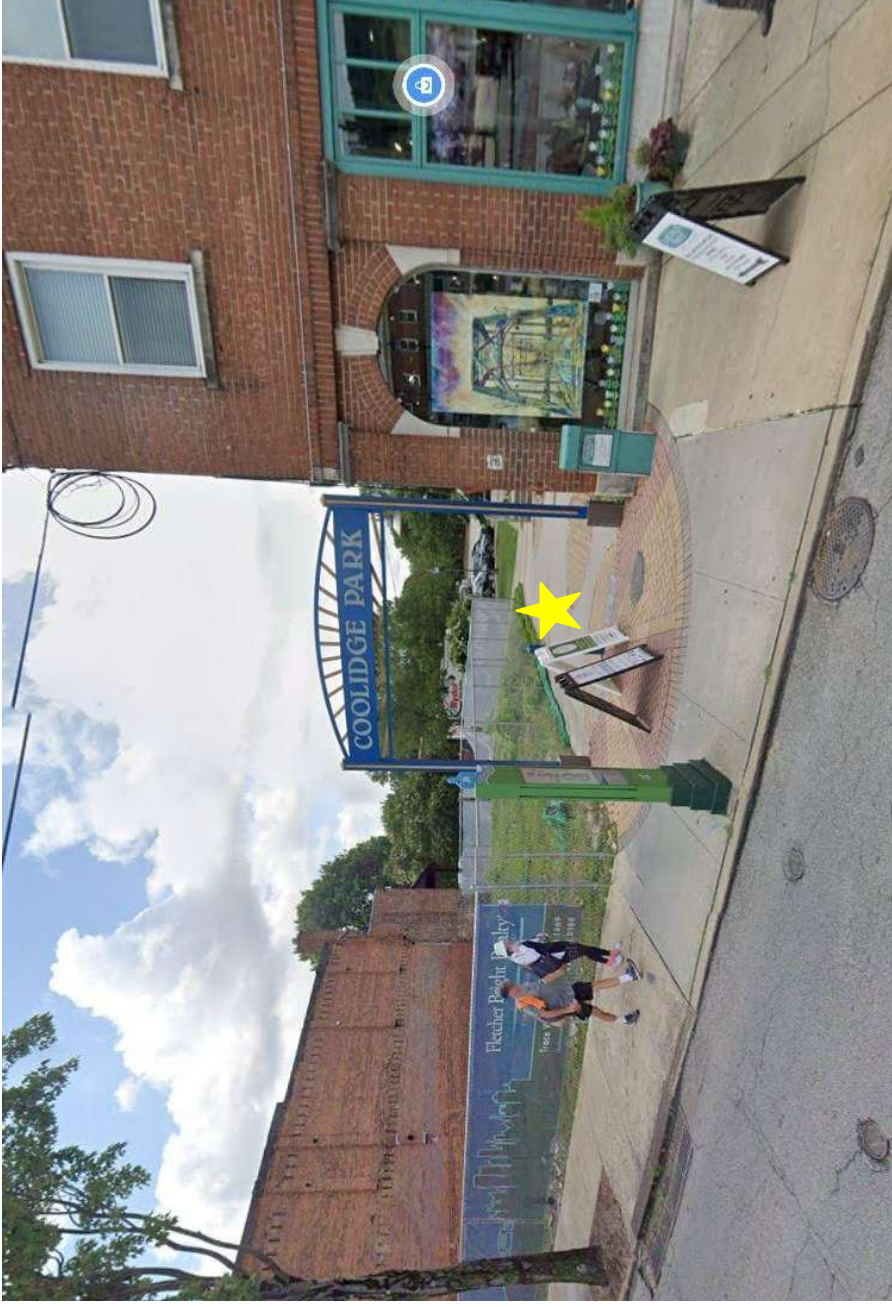

3. Downtown Chattanooga - Miller Plaza / Market St. and MLK Jr. Blvd.

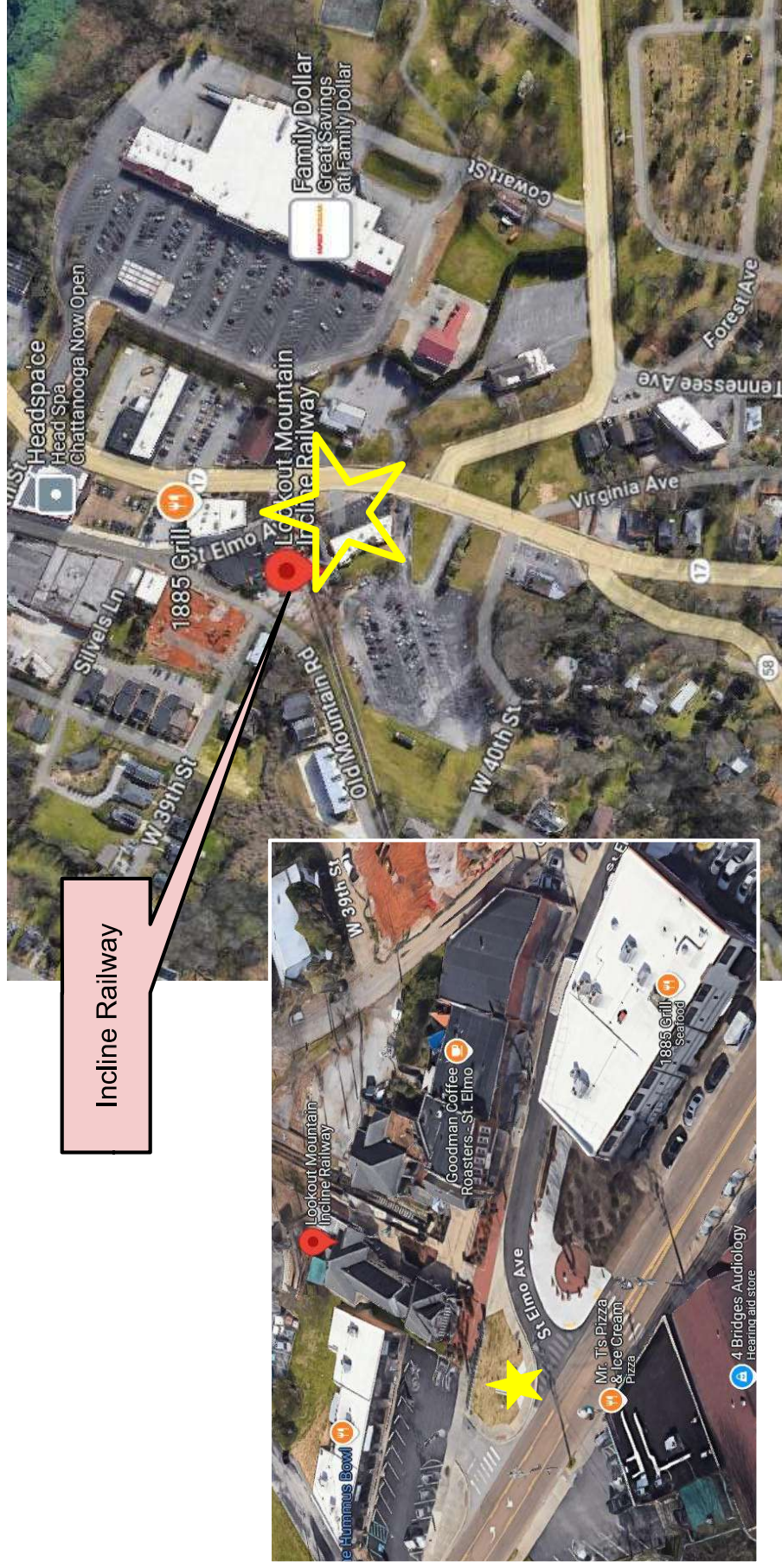
