## FINAL CONCEPT DESIGN - PLAN

#### **Concept Outline**

This design concept features a central tech island as the focal point, seamlessly guiding the park's flow. Adjacent lanes, equipped with ledges and flat bars, cater to a range of skill levels, ensuring accessibility for all users. The northern section includes an inviting entry plaza that connects the park to existing parking, highlighted by a sculptural volcano feature and integrated seat walls within the proposed greenspace. Additionally, vegetative buffering and bio-retention swales enhance security and provide a natural separation from oncoming traffic along Beardsley Road.
