Art Vision

The City of Wichita envisions four painted murals that are contextually relevant to O.J. Watson Park's aesthetic and that act as landmarks to each area of the park they belong to. The artwork for this project can represent the following aspects of the park:

- Activities and amenities that the park is known for, including fishing, pony rides, miniature golf, paddle boating, kayaking, volleyball, and mini-train rides, among others.
- The park's natural and environmental landscape qualities

Artwork must be durable and materials suitable to the extreme Kansas weather. Audial/lighting components will not be allowed. No found objects should be used for this project.





Mural Locations

The park is east of S McLean Blvd and north of W 30th St, at 3022 S McLean Blvd, Wichita, KS 67217. The restrooms are scattered throughout the park, each are labelled in the map according to their nearby amenity/feature. The orientation of the mural is listed below for each building:

Pony Stables: North-facing towards road

Concessions: South-facing, towards the parking lot

Entrance: North-facing towards road

Playground: West-facing towards road



Mural Locations: Concessions

Concessions dimensions of Southern side: 18' in length, 6'10" in height
Concessions dimensions Western side: 30' in length, 6'11" in height



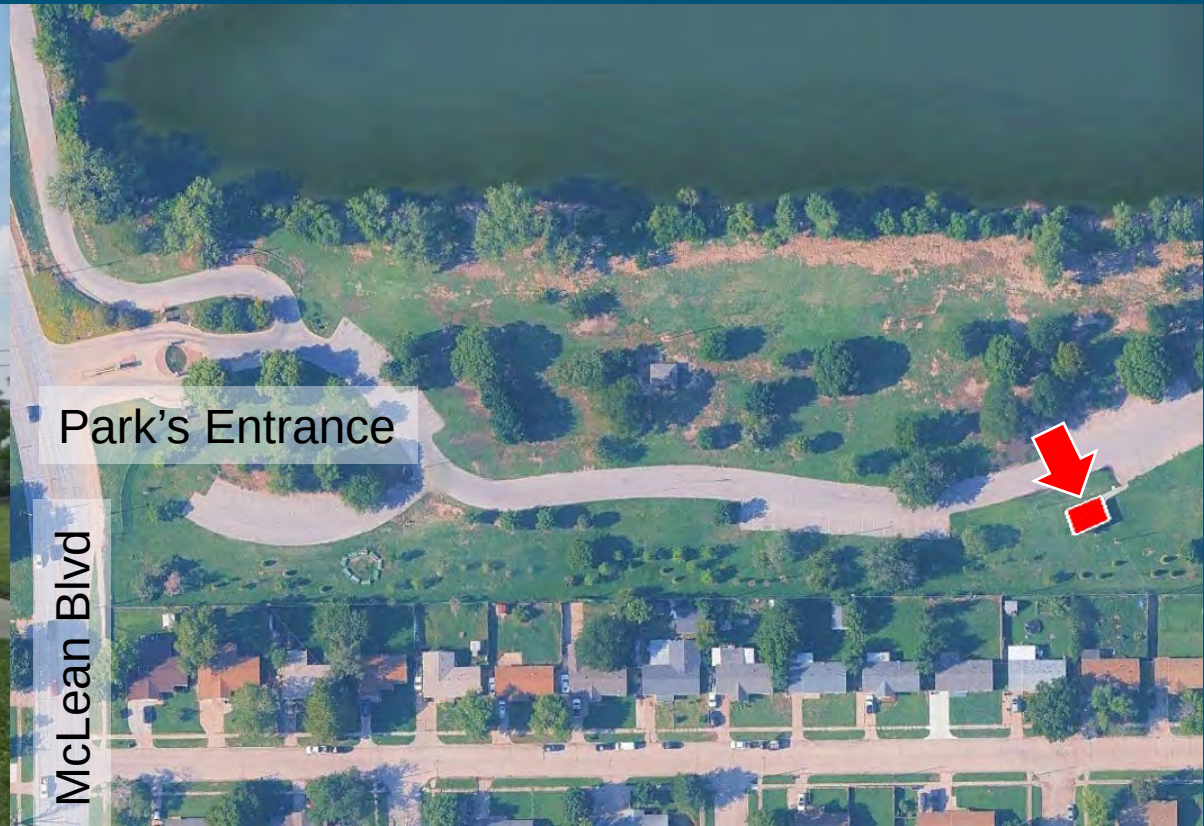
Mural Locations: Pony Stables
