The Center Park is an expansive green space of 50,000 square feet, on the south side of the Center for the Arts, framed by views of Snow King Mountain and the surrounding buttes.


Center for the Arts houses 20 arts and education nonprofit organizations and is home to dance studios, many art studios, art galleries, a black box theater, and a 500-seat state-of-the-art theater.

This is a high visibility, high traffic space, with more than 100,000 visitors to campus each year.

Works in this space must complement, not constrain, the park's flexible use for diverse summer events. Works should will enhance these events and provide opportunities for further public engagement.


