



- 1 River Walk** – A an accessible walking loop in the Upper Floodplain Terrace with Century Oak, maintained grass areas, and river views
- 2 Upper Floodplain Terrace** –the highest elevations of the site to the northeast include an oak savannah with native shrubs and native perennial grassland.
- 3 The Ridge** – spine through the site’s center separating the Box Elder Seep and the River Marsh zones.
- 4 River Marsh** – adjacent to the Napa River along the southeastern side of the Preserve, would include an expanded brackish marsh. The marsh is supplied by seasonal tidal water fluctuations from the river.

- 7 Riparian Terrace** – canopy break in the lower riparian woodland planted with native grasses.
- 8 The Point** – the southernmost extent of the site that is above high tide elevation
- 9 River Edge** – the steep riverbank edges along the eastern and western sides of the peninsula.
- 10 Box Elder Seep** – comprised of vegetation dominated by box elder (*Acer negundo*) trees and includes a depressional freshwater pond.
