#### **AVAILABLE SITES**

The City of Durango has three available bases and anticipates installation in spring 2016. Artists may request consideration for a specific location, however the final placement will be determined by the Public Art Commission. The following is a description of the sites:

### A19 - 8<sup>th</sup> Street Pocket Park

This location (A19 on the attached City of Durango Public Art Locations) is in the downtown area in a pocket park on  $8^{th}$  Street between  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  Avenues and is adjacent to a City parking lot. The site features a 4-foot-diameter round concrete base with metal plates.

### B2 – Iris Park (available May 2016)

This location (B2 on the attached City of Durango Public Art Locations) is along the Animas River Trail near Iris Park and next to the pedestrian bridge over the Animas River. It features an 8-foot-diameter round concrete base with metal plates.




### **B4** – Dogleg near 9<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge
