

RFQ for the CO-GENERATION PUBLIC ART PROJECT (images)

The new Co-Generation Facility will be located on Los Esteros Road which is predominately travelled by RWF and landfill employees. It is also an alternate route in and out of Alviso and used by residents. The current Co-Generation Facility program calls for screening the four 50-foot-high emissions treatment exhaust stacks with a simple perforated metal screen.

While there are programmatic and structural constraints, there exists the potential to address this public-facing façade, with a 2-dimensional integrated approach to aesthetically enhancing the surface. Other 3-dimensional sculptural approaches will also be considered.



Conceptually this is an opportunity for education and inspiration. It is also an opportunity to contribute, and promote, ESD's sustainability goals for the RFQ by incorporating functional energy producing elements.
