Amuse Yeux

A Small Delight for the Eyes

CALL FOR ENTRIES

A play on the term used in restaurants, amuse bouche, meaning a bite –sized appetizer. *Amuse Yeux* is a mixed media small works show which will present the visual equivalent in a refined gallery setting. The motivation for this show was to provide an opportunity for young adults in our community to begin art collections at an entry level price point. Often times the exceptional artwork for sale in the galleries of FAC can be cost prohibitive to the masses. By hosting a show of small works, many of them created just for this instance, we can lower the price of the works without sacrificing quality. The staff at FAC invites you to enter small work in any media (guidelines below) in a show that is sure to be the *delight* of all our visitors.

This show will be juried by Eriq Hochuli, Curator with the aid of the FAC Board of Directors.

Now in its 3rd year this show continues to grow as a diverse, quirky and dynamic exhibit of about 60 works hung in a salon style.

About FAC:

Located in historic downtown Golden, FAC's mission is inspiring and engaging the community through arts, education, and a creative exchange of ideas. Founded in 1968 and an official member of the United States National Registry of Historic Buildings, the main gallery is housed in an 1872 Gothic style church and an 1892 Queen Anne style manse, set behind a sculpture garden designed by Saarinen Landscape Architecture. This show is installed in our Community Gallery, it is among the first things visitors see when they arrive in our building.

ELIGIBILITY

- Two dimensional works may be entered.
- Three dimensional works may be entered.
- All media are eligible, including alternative media.
- Framed works must include all hardware and be ready for hanging. Unframed work must be gallery ready. Please email with any specific questions.
- Piece must be 10 inches or less in any dimension (without framing); so 10" x 10" x 10" is the maximum size – **exceptions may be cleared with staff, please email eriq@foothillsartcenter.org directly, before entering. There will be no refunds issued for failing to adhere to guidelines.**
- Please keep the thickness of frames concurrent with the scale of the work. Frames larger than 3 in in thickness may require replacement.
- Artwork must have a sales price of \$300 or below.
- All entries must be one-of-a-kind (all forms of printmaking are ok) and original, no giclee.
- Artwork may not have been shown previously in any exhibition at FAC.
- Juried artists may enter up to three pieces of art; only one may be accepted for inclusion in the exhibition.
- Source material must be your own design or made from your own photograph.

ACCEPTANCE & DELIVERY OF WORK

In years past this show has ~ 75% acceptance rate. This is highly dependent on the number of works entered. Accepted artists will deliver the specific works of art selected by the jury process. FAC will send accepted artists detailed information regarding delivery and pickup. Curator, Eriq Hochuli will coordinate with accepted artists on scheduling alternative delivery appointments if necessary.

DELIVERY AND RETURN OF ACCEPTED WORK

- **Detailed instructions will be sent with notification of acceptance.**
- All artists shipping work **must** provide a pre-paid return-shipping label packaged along with their artwork. Unsold work will not be returned without a prepaid return-shipping label.
- FAC is not responsible for damage or loss during transport. Please arrange for protection or insurance at your discretion.
- FAC provides insurance for artworks while on premises.

SALES

FAC retains a 30% (reduced 10% from last year) commission on all art sales. Prices may not be changed after delivery of artwork. Payment for sold artwork will be issued 30 days after the close of the exhibition. Artwork that is not for sale cannot be included in this exhibition.

AGREEMENT

Submission to this juried exhibition constitutes an agreement on the part of the entrant to the conditions set forth in this prospectus. FAC reserves the right to final curatorial, educational, installation and marketing decisions.

HOW TO ENTER

1. Prepare your digital image before applying.
2. Set up your free CaFÉ portfolio
3. Apply through https://www.callforentry.org/register_info.php.
4. Artists may enter up to three works of art.
5. The entry fee is \$10 for up to three entries to be paid by credit card through the CaFÉ website.
6. CaFÉ requires that all images conform to a specific format. FAC encourages all entrants to review the instructions and tutorials for formatting images and entering before beginning the actual entry process.
7. Submissions will include the following:
 - a. Contact information, including mailing address, telephone number, e-mail address, and website address (if applicable).

- b. Title and media of each work submitted. Labels are made with this information, so be sure to proofread.
 - c. Brief statement about the work. This may include descriptive material. Limit to 500 words. Be sure to use this opportunity to describe your process and specific use of media.
