

Hobbs Site Locations – TIME Project 2020

Location One – Lovington Highway Health Walk Trail

The Hobbs Local Selection Committee has identified a segment of this 7.15 mile long walking trail ending on the North end at the Medical Center and ending on the South end at Green Meadows Lake (see aerial photo below). This linear park meanders along the west side of the Lovington Highway and provides a lush, green welcome to those arriving in Hobbs from the north. This project provides opportunities for community members to walk, jog, bike, and enjoy a public space 24 hours a day. Due to the scale of this area the Local Selection Committee would like to see at least two installations along this trail.

Location Two – Lea County Center for the Arts (122 W Broadway St, Hobbs, NM 88240)

The Lea County Center for the Arts is a non-profit organization in which all art forms come together under one roof. LCCA is dedicated to bringing quality art shows, exhibitions, concerts, and performances. Located in the heart of downtown Hobbs, this location provides a covered outdoor pavilion area (approximately 20 x 20 feet) located west of the LCCA building. This location also provides an indoor installation site. Both indoor and outdoor sites at this location have access to electricity. Indoor space also includes storefront windows. Interior showroom measures approximately 58 x 34 feet. The covered entry in front of the building measures approximately 24 x 37 feet.
